ORDINANCE NO. 2395

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 52, SECTION 52-117 TO PROHIBIT TRAILERS FROM PARKING ON A CITY STREET, ALLEY OR PUBLIC PARKING FOR MORE THAN 48 HOURS CONSECUTIVELY; TO CREATE AN EXCEPTION; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YORK, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Chapter 52, section 52-117 is amended as follows:

Sec. 52-117. Parking prohibited for more than 48 hours.

No motor vehicle or trailer shall be continuously parked on any street, alley or other public property within the City for more than 48 hours consecutively, except trailers and roll-offs used for temporary construction projects for which permission has been obtained for their placement as provided by section 44-94.

<u>Section 2.</u> All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3</u>. This ordinance take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication pursuant to law.
