Discussion of 2025/26 Budget

Proposal to request \$10,000 from LB 357 funds to support sustainability for Cultural Festival (\$3,500); to support Icon Art Project (\$3,500) (in strategic plan); and ongoing arts projects and collaborations (\$3,000).

Include in budget \$10,000 for possible donations and up to \$15,000 for York Visitor's Bureau promotional grants to support sustainability for digital promotional strategy; and promotion of cultural district activities.

Discussion of upcoming Cultural Festival:


